**T**heodore G. Miller, age 93, of Oshkosh passed away on Sunday, March 24, 2013. He was born on October 3rd, 1919, in Oshkosh, WI, the son of Joseph & Rose (Nigl) Miller. Ted was preceded in death by his parents and infant daughter Mary, along with six brothers Eugene, Gabe, George, Norbert, Vince, and Joe. Three sisters Caroline (Sr. Gabriel), Marie, and Rita.

Ted was a lifelong resident of Oshkosh and attended St. Vincent's school. He enjoyed golfing, fishing, and socializing with friends and co-workers.
