P Vivian DuPrey, age 92, of Oshkosh, died peacefully on January 29, 2014 after an illness of several months. She was born in Escondido, California to the late Edward and Prudence (Browne) Boylan on March 30 , 1921. Vivian was a graduate of Wrightstown High School, Outagamie Normal School and the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh. She married Robert J. DuPrey in St. John's Church in Morrison on August 17, 1940. Winning prizes at the county fair for her penmanship, it was inevitable that she would become a teacher. Her career began in the Brown County rural schools, continued in the Winnebago County rural schools (Knott, Maple, Oakwood and Sunset). It culminated in the Winneconne Public Schools when she retired in 1981. Vivian said, "I had the perfect job". The sincere statement was verified by teachers, families and students who maintained contact throughout the years. She cherished their visits and greetings. Vivian enjoyed restaurants and travel. Proud of her Irish heritage, a favorite memory was her trip to Ireland. She was a faithful member of St. Jude the Apostle Parish, Sacred Heart Catholic Church for over 60 years. She also belonged to WEAC-Retired, WCREA, and Rockwell Lunch Retired Group.
