Betty (Washburn) Fisher, age 83, of Oshkosh, passed away on January 24, 2014. She was born on December 30, 1930 in Omro, Wisconsin. She was the daughter of the late George & Alma (Fritz) Washburn. Betty married Stanley Fisher on March 19, 1949 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Omro, Wisconsin. She was a military wife who traveled with her husband on many assignments in the U.S. and Europe. She was a craft-maker; including sewing, knitting, crocheting, ceramics, doll making, Christmas ornaments and stamping greeting cards. After her husband Stanley, retired, they purchased a motor home and traveled around the United States visiting many areas of the country.
