Phillip J. Nett, age 78 of Oshkosh, passed away on Sunday, November 9, 2008 in the Bethel Home. On September 16, 1930 he was born in Oshkosh, the son of Joseph and Theresa (Schmitz) Nett. Phillip worked as a millworker at American Excelsior and Georgia Pacific. He was a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church. He served in the U.S. Army and the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War. Woodworking, reading, playing cards, making cookies were among his hobbies. He was an avid Packer fan. Family was very important to Phillip, so he made arrangements for a park to hold holiday picnics. He enjoyed his family, especially his grandchildren. On March 25, 1947 he married Joyce Bricco in Oshkosh.
