# **Dorothy A. Schroeder**

**D**orothy A. Schroeder, age 91 of Oshkosh, passed away Thursday, October 15, 2009 in the Bethel Home. On May 15, 1918 she was born in Oshkosh, the daughter of Frank and Mary (Eppinger) Reischl. She worked as a seamstress at Neubuergers in Oshkosh, and she also worked at LaRista, Warners and Gimbles in Bridgeport, CT, and at Ruthanne's in Oshkosh. On June 29, 1938 she married Carl Schroeder in Vincent's Catholic Church in Oshkosh. He preceded her in death on June 2, 1981.
