She was born on June 8, 1924 in Oshkosh, a daughter of the late August C. and Marie Kloiber Schulz. Florence married James G. Sarres on January 31, 1956 at St. John's Catholic Church and also on May 20, 1964 in James' church, Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church in Fond du Lac. James preceded her in death in 2005. She was a lifelong member of St. John's Catholic Church in Oshkosh. She is survived by and her memory will be cherished by two sister-in-laws and ten very loved nieces, nephews and their children along with great, great nieces, nephews other relatives and many very dear friends. She was preceded in death by a sister, Carole M. Dolan; brothers, LaVerne E. and August J. Schulz. Florence was employed at the Oshkosh National Bank for twenty-two years, becoming the first woman bank officer, and developing a women's dept. there. She was listed in Who's Who of American Women in 1953.
