Benjamin B. Hiebel, age 88, of Oshkosh, passed away on Tuesday evening, February 10, 2015 at Mercy Medical Center. He was born on March 13, 1926 in Ripon, a son of the late Benjamin and Lillian (Kloehn) Hiebel. Ben moved to Joliet, IL when he was five years old and then moved to Santa Anna, California. He had also been a deputy sheriff for Winnebago County for many years and had also helped the new owner of Thompson Studio, his good friend, start a good business.
