## **Helen M. Nigl**

**H**elen Mary Nigl, age 94, of Oshkosh, passed away on January 31, 2018 at Bella Vista. She was born April 18, 1923 on the family farm in Lebanon Co., PA, the 10th of 12 children of Aaron and Agnes (Arnold) Hartman. She was a 1940 graduate of Jonestown High School and worked at Bethlehem Steel factory in Lebanon during WWII.

Helen married Robert Nigl on April 14, 1945 at St. Mary of the Assumption Catholic Church in Lebanon, PA. They moved to Oshkosh that June.
