She bred and owned many champion Gordon Setters including dogs with national rankings. Her interest in purebred dogs continued throughout her life and she currently owns a young up and coming dog. 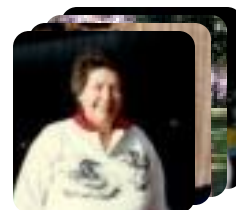
