On January 29, 1949, she married Melvin Poeschl of Oshkosh and they enjoyed 69 years together before Mel’s passing in 2018. They had a full life of family, friends, and travel. 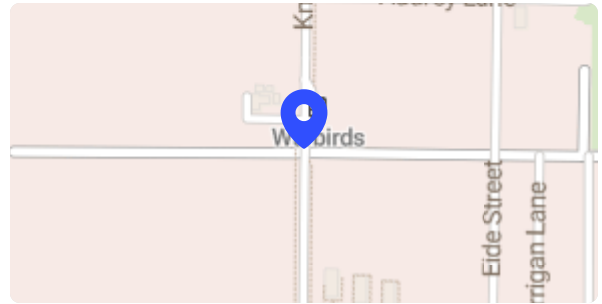

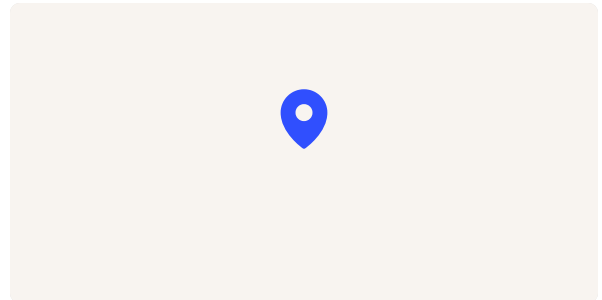
