Amelia was the youngest of five children, John Jr., Albert, Pauline, Emma and Ella. She was born in Longmont, CO on March 4, 1921 the daughter of John and Mary (Stugart) Leinweber. Amelia went to school in a one room school house, 1st through 8th grade in Wheatland, WY. She moved to Oshkosh when she was 17. Many years later she met and married William “Lefty” Schuhart on July 10, 1942. They had 53 years together. Amelia was a longtime member at Zion Lutheran Church in Oshkosh, she enjoyed ice fishing, fishing, bowling and gardening.
