**R**obert “Bob” Francis Rademacher, age 85, of Fond du Lac, lifted off from Bethel Home in Oshkosh on Saturday January 22, 2022. He was born the son of the late Paul Herbert and Marie Louise Jaeger Rademacher in Escanaba, MI on April 5, 1936. He graduated from St. Joseph's in Escanaba, attended St. Norbert College in DePere, WI, and married Sally Powell. Bob was a perpetual merrymaker, witty jokester, and the best, most selfless and generous Dad in the universe. He was also an unconditionally loving Boopa to his grandchildren. Bob proudly served his country in the U.S Air Force in Germany and France as an atomic armorer during the Cold War. After his service, he worked as rocket engineer for General Electric in Philadelphia. He was Vice President/Plant Engineer for Tolibia Cheese in the 70s and 80s, after which he began his own company, Unicell Inc. in Reedsburg, WI.

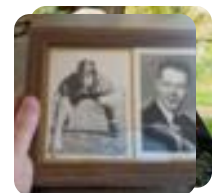
