Jeanne attended St. Peter and St. Vincent Grade Schools and then graduated from Oshkosh High School in 1948. In 1952, she graduated from WI State University, Oshkosh (UWO) with a Bachelor of Science degree.

She married the love of her life, Milo F. McCabe of Oconomowoc, WI on August 25, 1956. He preceded her in death on April 5, 1987. 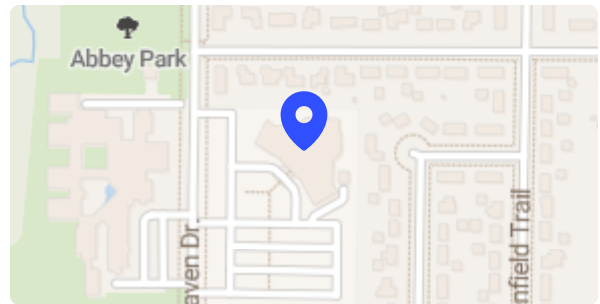

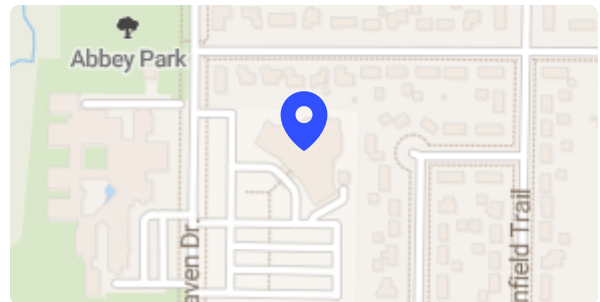
