In Lieu of flowers a memorial fund will be established in Barb’s name.

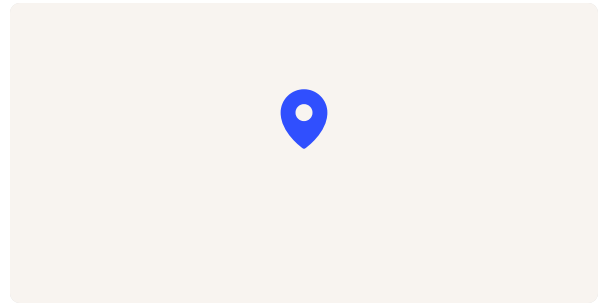
