# James Myron Wolff

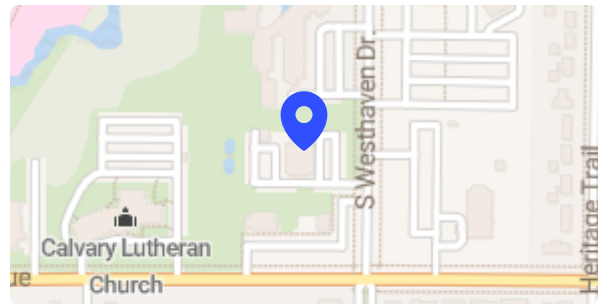

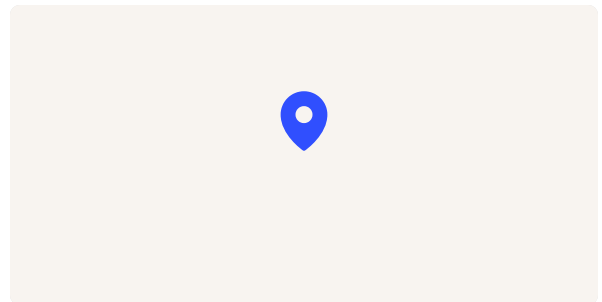

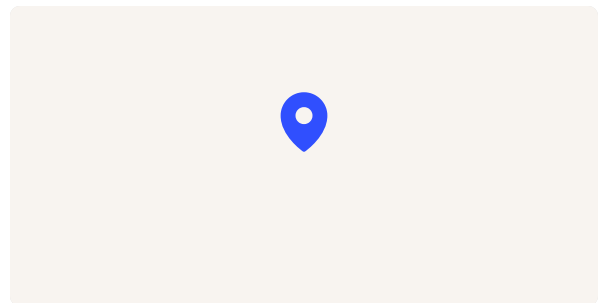
