Mike was a dedicated son, husband, father, and Grandfather who will be deeply missed and fondly remembered by all who knew him.



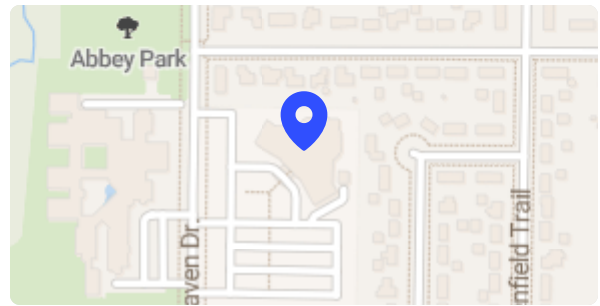

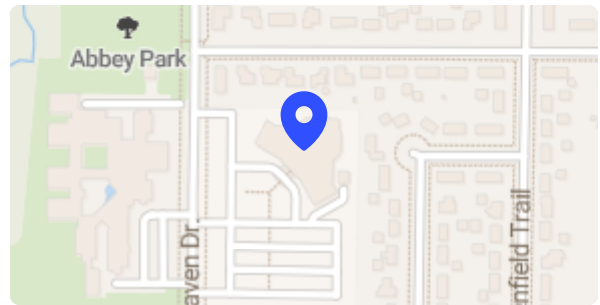
