James (Jim) Peter Schumacher, Jr., age 75, of Oshkosh, passed away peacefully at home, surrounded by his loving family, on September 5, 2025.

Born in Oshkosh on May 12, 1950, Jim was the son of the late James (Jim) P. Schumacher, Sr. and Betty Jane (Malnory). He proudly served his country in the U.S. Navy, stationed at Naval Station San Diego, CA. During the Vietnam War, he served as a Storekeeper Second Class (SK2, E-5) aboard the USS James E. Kyes.

After his military service, Jim pursued higher education and earned his bachelor's degree in Business Administration from the University of Wisconsin–Oshkosh. 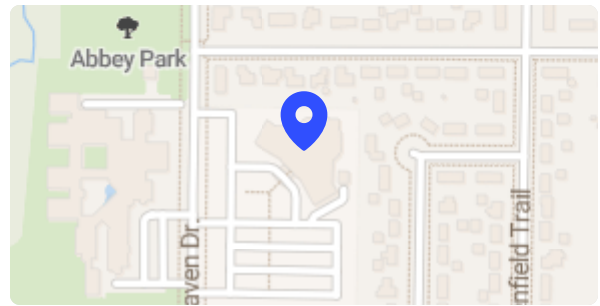

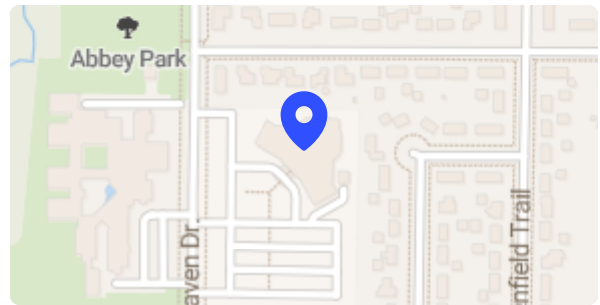
